A Continuum of Services ... A Continuum of Care

- ★ **EDUCATION SERVICES**, Northwest Village School and The Academy at Wheeler Clinic, largest approved private special education facility in Connecticut, enrolls children and teenagers with serious behavior challenges who are referred by public schools from 60 towns.
- ★ **MENTAL HEALTH OUTPATIENT SERVICES**, serves children, families and adults. Treats depression, anxiety, behavior problems, couples' difficulties, school and work difficulties, serious mental illness.
- ★ **SUBSTANCE ABUSE OUTPATIENT TREATMENT**, provides individual and group interventions of varying intensity and duration.
- ★ **SPECIALIZED BEHAVIORAL HEALTH TREATMENT PROVIDER** for consumers with special needs, including: domestic violence, sexual abuse, anger management, divorce, eating disorders, gambling and others.
- ★ **CRISIS INTERVENTION** for children and adults, sends teams into homes, schools and other community settings to help individuals who are suicidal, out-of-control or in severe distress facing hospitalization or arrest.
- ★ **INTENSIVE HOME-BASED SERVICES** for children, adolescents and families with psychiatric and substance abuse diagnoses, these programs are based on nationally recognized treatment models.
- ★ **24 HOUR, HOME-LIKE CONGREGATE CARE FOR CHILDREN** in six different settings for children who cannot live with their families but who need other resources or to stay connected to their parents and communities while they work out their problems.
- ★ **THERAPEUTIC FOSTER CARE PROGRAM** licenses families who welcome children who cannot live with their families, providing extra supports for the placement of children with special behavioral health or medical needs.
- ★ **COURT-MANDATED AND COURT DIVERSION EDUCATION PROGRAMS** for individuals arrested for driving-while-intoxicated (DWI); court-required parenting education for divorcing couples; intervention and risk reduction programs for individuals who are pre-trial, on probation or parole.
- ★ **EMPLOYEE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM** unit serves more than 90 area employers who contract with Wheeler Clinic for consultation, training, and counseling for employees whose personal problems interfere with job performance.
- ★ **THE CONNECTICUT CENTER FOR PREVENTION, WELLNESS & RECOVERY** is the state's most comprehensive resource for behavioral health information and a leading provider of professional training and development opportunities, and prevention and health promotion services statewide.
- ★ **PREVENTION AND EDUCATION PROGRAMS** to reduce substance abuse, violence, bullying, child abuse; promoting child development, wellness, successful parenting and positive youth development.
