About the Alternative in the Community:

Wheeler Clinic's Alternative in the Community programs offer community-based intervention services for adults involved with the court or probation. The program uses a curriculum-driven, evidence-based model designed to assess the needs of each individual and reduce their involvement in the criminal justice system. Services include:

- Substance abuse intervention
- Skill building
- Community service opportunities
- Job development and placement
- Case management
- Educational, basic needs and vocational supports
- Gender-responsive programming

Our outcomes:

- Wheeler Clinic's established Alternative in the Community Program **consistently exceeds state and adjusted town benchmarks for recidivism** – individuals completing the program are less likely to re-offend.
- The established program also **consistently achieves high scores in program proficiency**. * (NOTE: Wheeler Clinic recently acquired three additional programs.)

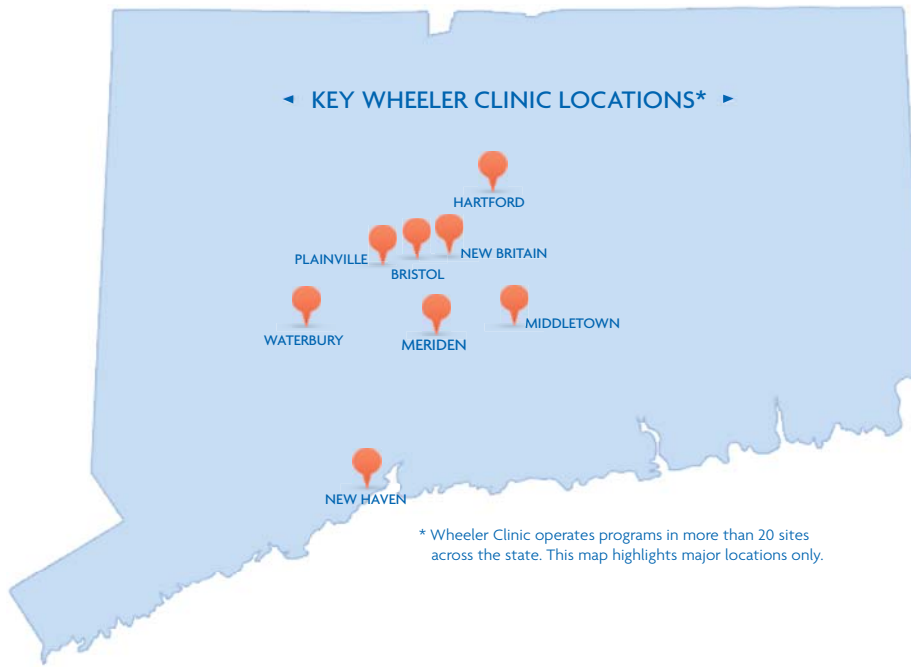
