We provide state-of-the-art, evidence-based practices such as Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT) and Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy.

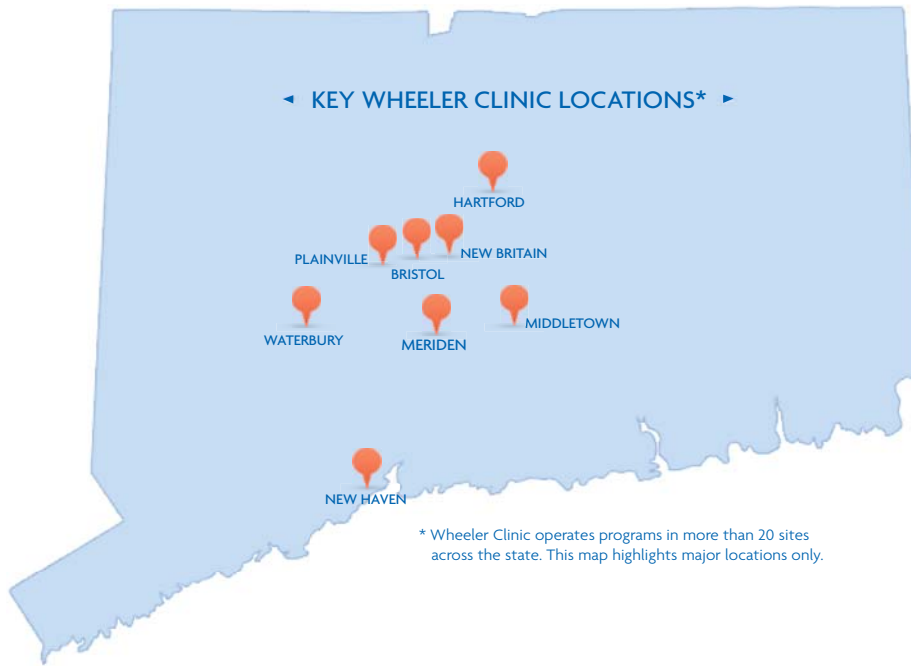
