## About Our Family Support Center:

---

Wheeler Clinic's Family Support Center serves youth, age 11 through 16, who are truant, have runaway or are otherwise out of his or her parents' control. The program provides comprehensive assessment, intervention, parent support, crisis response, referral, case management and psycho-educational groups in a supportive environment. We use a strengths-based, family-centered approach that includes involvement of the family and community. Each youth receives an individually tailored service plan that integrates all aspects of his or her life.

## Our approach helps youth:

---

- Develop healthy social skills
- Reduce anger and aggression
- Improve educational functioning
- Learn problem solving and coping skills
- Avoid alcohol and drugs
- Improve relationships with family members

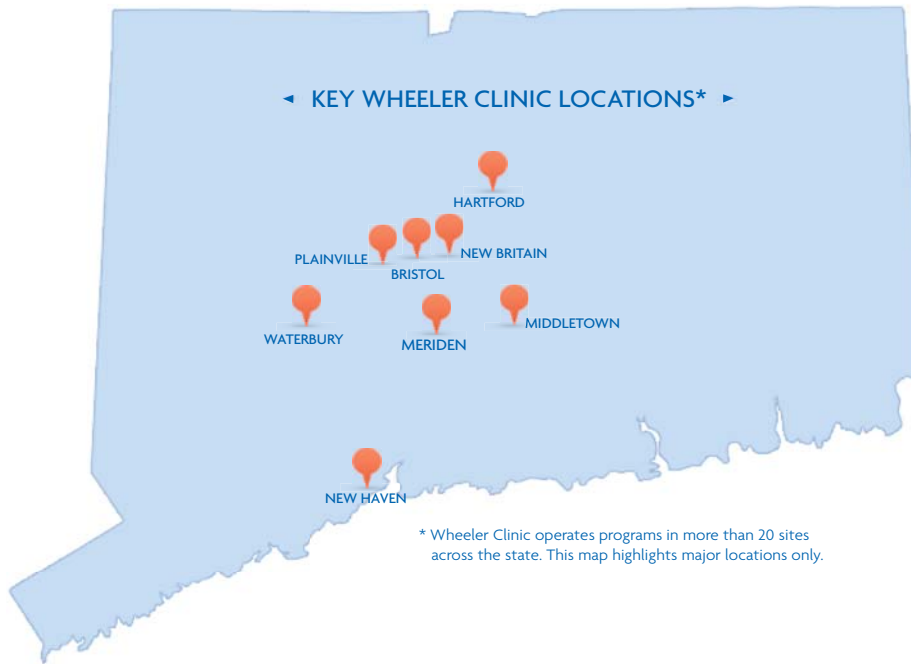
