About MDFT-RAFT:

The MDFT-RAFT program assists high-risk youth, ages 12-18, transitioning back to their communities following a period of incarceration. The program includes targeted approaches for adolescents with a history of substance abuse and other behavioral issues. Our team treats the individual adolescent, the caretakers, and the family and builds on the systems and supports in that youth's life. Staff work with the youth and family prior to their release, reconnect youth with their family at home, and then link them to ongoing services in the community.

We serve youth and their families in:

Greater New Britain, Greater Hartford, Greater Waterbury, Greater New Haven and Greater Bridgeport

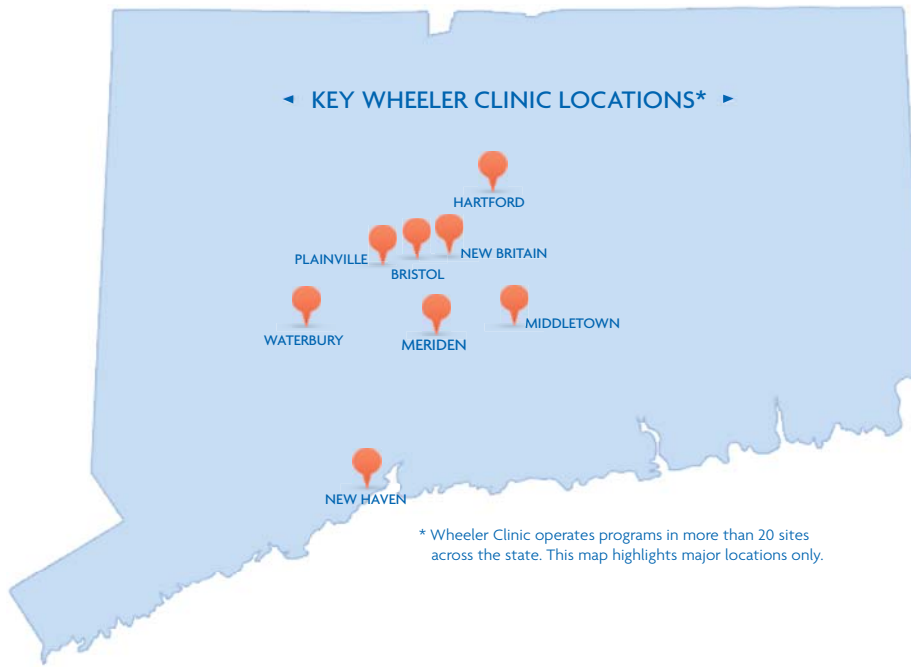
