About Northwest Village School:

Northwest Village School is a therapeutic day school designed for special education students, ages 4 - 21, who exhibit complex social, emotional, learning and/or behavioral challenges that have resulted in a Planning and Placement Team decision to seek placement outside of a traditional public school setting.

Northwest Village School* offers:

- A team approach led by highly trained special education teachers, psychotherapists, psychiatric nurses, speech and language pathologists, occupational therapists and para-professionals
- Individualized programming designed to build on each student's learning style and unique strengths to address their complex educational and mental health needs
- Close collaboration and communication between students, families, school districts and community providers involved with referred students
- Students grouped by age, abilities and their individual learning style
- Transition programming for students 18 - 21 years of age
- Pre-vocational programming in the areas of culinary, automotive, retail, housekeeping/maintenance and farming/agriculture (including off-site job coaching)

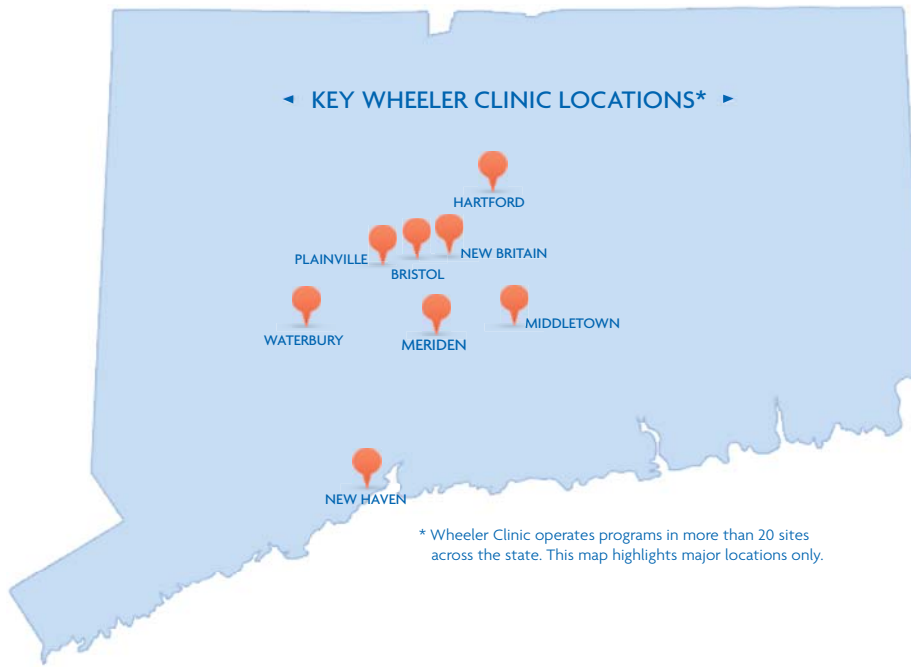
