The mission of the program is to help DCF families thrive by finding homes in safe, nurturing neighborhoods, achieving economic independence, developing healthy relationships, and providing their children with a stable and caring home environment.

Services include:

- Assisting clients in securing housing subsidy and/or rental housing
- Providing transportation
- Providing clients with referrals, advocacy, crisis intervention and counseling services, as needed
- Coordinating substance abuse treatment such as Relapse Prevention, Children's Services, Education Support and Parenting Training

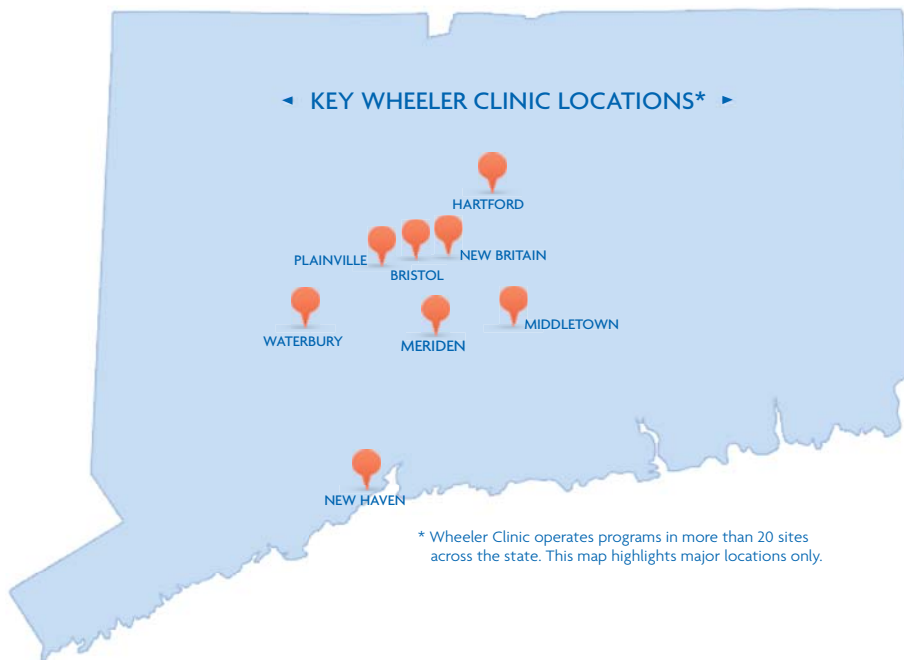
