Northwest Village School* offers:

- A team approach comprised of highly trained special education teachers, psychotherapists, psychiatric nurses, speech and language pathologists, occupational therapists and paraprofessionals
- Individualized programming designed to build on each student's learning style and unique strengths to address their complex educational and mental health needs
- Close collaboration and communication between students, families, school districts and community providers involved with referred students
- Students grouped by age, abilities and their individual learning style
- Transition programming for students 18 21 years of age
- Pre-vocational programming in the areas of culinary, automotive, retail, housekeeping/maintenance and farming/ agriculture (including off-site job coaching)
