- ★ **MENTAL HEALTH OUTPATIENT SERVICES** for children, families, and adults. Treats depression, anxiety, behavior problems, couples' difficulties, school and work difficulties, and severe mental illness.
- ★ **FAMILY HEALTH & WELLNESS CENTERS**, provide an integrated, comprehensive continuum of patient-centered primary care, dental, pediatrics, women's health services, behavioral health, complementary medicine, community health workers, HIV/AIDS medical case management, and care management and nutrition services.
- ★ **SUBSTANCE ABUSE OUTPATIENT TREATMENT**, provides individual and group interventions of varying intensity and duration, as well as medication-assisted treatment (MAT) and peer recovery supports.

- ★ **CRISIS INTERVENTION** sends teams into homes, schools and other community settings to help individuals, including children, who are experiencing behavioral health emergencies, as well as crisis stabilization homes for adolescents.
- ★ **INTENSIVE HOME-BASED SERVICES** for children, adolescents and families with psychiatric and substance abuse diagnoses. These programs are based on nationally recognized, evidence-based treatment models.
- ★ **24 HOUR, HOME-LIKE CONGREGATE CARE FOR CHILDREN** in five different settings for children who cannot live with their own families but who need other resources or to stay connected to their parents and communities while they work out their problems.
- ★ **THERAPEUTIC FOSTER CARE PROGRAM** licenses families who welcome children who cannot live with their families, providing extra supports for the placement of children with special behavioral health or medical needs.
- ★ **COURT-MANDATED AND COURT DIVERSION EDUCATION PROGRAMS** for individuals arrested for driving-while-intoxicated (DWI); court-required parenting education for divorcing couples; intervention and risk reduction programs for individuals who are pre-trial, on probation, or parole.
- ★ **EMPLOYEE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM** serves employers who contract with Wheeler for consultation, training, and counseling for employees whose personal problems interfere with job performance.
- ★ **CONNECTICUT CENTER FOR PREVENTION, WELLNESS & RECOVERY** is the state's most comprehensive resource for behavioral health information and a leading provider of professional training and development opportunities, and prevention and health promotion services statewide.
- ★ **PREVENTION AND EDUCATION PROGRAMS** to reduce substance abuse, violence, bullying, and child abuse and promote child development, wellness, successful parenting and positive youth development.
- ★ **EARLY CHILDHOOD SERVICES** like Birth to Three, Child First, and Parent Connections, provide a continuum of support that engages young children and their families in the vital first few years of life, ensuring children can learn and grow.
