AUGUST IS IMMUNIZATION AWARENESS MONTH

August is National Immunization Awareness Month, an observance designed to remind people about the importance of getting vaccinated at every stage of life. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, there are 14 <u>vaccine-preventable diseases</u> from which you can protect your child before the age of two, and several for <u>adults</u>, especially as they age. You can protect yourself and your family against serious conditions such as whooping cough, cancers caused by HPV, shingles, pneumonia, and more by getting recommended vaccines.

Wheeler's <u>Family Health & Wellness Centers</u> in Bristol, New Britain, Hartford, and Waterbury offer vaccines and/or links to resources in the community to ensure you are up to date on recommended immunizations. Talk to your doctor, nurse, or other health care professional to ensure that you, your child, and your family are up to date or have a plan for vaccines.

Also, as your children head back to school, make sure vaccinations are at the top of your checklist. August is also a key time to make sure you are up to date on all the vaccines you need to stay healthy. Use CDC's adult vaccine assessment tool to see which <u>vaccines</u> might be right for you.
