INVEST IN A MORE JUST TOMORROW AND A BETTER TODAY

Our programs address every axis of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's five social determinants of health. Investing in programs and services that address these issues can change lives and improve health and wellness outcomes.

Health Care Access and Quality. Our five Family Health & Wellness Centers are federally qualified health centers, focused on serving the state's most medically underserved and vulnerable populations. An investment in this area keeps Connecticut healthy.

Education Access and Quality. Our Northwest Village School provides state-of-the-art special education and integrated clinical services for students from more than 60 districts across Connecticut. Investments in our students help make a better tomorrow for them, and their families.



Social and Community Context. Our focus on equity, diversity, and systemic injustice informs everything we do. Private investments in LGBTQIA+, racially, and ethnically responsive services means we meet our patients where they are in their lived experiences.

Economic Stability. Investing in our Basic Needs Fund directly supports patients living daily with poverty, unemployment, or food and housing insecurity.

Neighborhood and Built Environment. Many of Wheeler's patients do not have access to healthy groceries, safe places to exercise, or transportation. Private

investments can directly address these disparities through our nutrition programming, complementary medicine services, fitness efforts, and much more.



INVEST IN WELLNESS FOR ALL

Keep New Britain Families Healthier

Our new Family Health & Wellness Center at 40 Hart Street in New Britain addresses vital community needs. Wheeler has provided care to the Hardware City since 1991, and this expansion brings a new, fully integrated, expanded continuum of care, including OB-GYN services, pediatrics, and behavioral health for all ages.

Integrated Services for Bristol Individuals, Families

Wheeler's first community health center site in 2013, our Family Health & Wellness Centers in Bristol are planning to consolidate to a new, accessible downtown site (top right) which allows us to expand services such as nutrition and wellness services and meet other unmet primary care and behavioral health needs in the community.

Reduce Social Inequity in Hartford

Our flagship community health center, the Susan Walkama Family Health & Wellness Center, serves the capital city with fully integrated on-site primary and behavioral health care, family dental, complementary medicine, and more. Priorities for growth include expanding our community health workers, Wheeler staff who live and work in the community, connecting residents to services and opportunities that help them live better, healthier lives.



Better Medical Care in Plainville

Wheeler's 91 Northwest Drive location is both our original site since 1972 and our newest community health center, and we are expanding services on-site to offer primary care, addiction treatment, and more. Your investment ensures that our patients, and students at Northwest Village School (located on-site), have convenient access to a full continuum of care.

Total Wellness in Waterbury

Our newly expanded community health center in Waterbury opened amid the pandemic in 2020, quickly recognizing the unmet need in the Brass City, particularly for medically underserved populations and families. Our vision for expanding in Waterbury includes new nutrition programming, chiropractic care, and more.



INVEST IN OUR STUDENTS IN SCHOOL AND BEYOND

Wheeler's Northwest Village School is a statewide leader in integrating a full continuum of services into a therapeutic day school model for its students and their families. We serve students from dozens of cities and towns across the state who can thrive in a more structured environment than they may be able to receive in their local district. Their needs expand beyond graduation, however, and two



areas are dramatically impacted by private investment:

Scholarship support. Investing in scholarships directly helps struggling families afford post-secondary education like trade schools, community colleges, and other career-guiding options.

Technology. Today's students are tomorrow's workforce, and private investments allow us to purchase equipment and technology to prepare our students for the vocational and professional careers of the future.

IN OUR COMMUNITY: "WALK WITH ME" LAUNCHED



Walk With Me, a specialized outpatient treatment track for LGBTQ+-identifying young people, ages 10-25, has launched, offering therapeutic, medical, and peer support to address patients' unique and specific needs.

The service track was funded through an anonymous \$100,000 gift to Wheeler in March, and is available at Wheeler's community health centers in Plainville and Hartford.

"Because of the visionary support of our donor, we were able to create Walk With Me and provide a safe space for all our patients with gender-affirming and trauma-informed approaches," says Sabrina Trocchi, PhD, MPA, president and chief executive officer of Wheeler.



Walk With Me utilizes individual, family, and group outpatient therapy, as well as psychiatry, medical services, and peer support, along with educational components, to meet transgender and gender nonbinary youth and young adults where they are—and

support them on their journey toward living healthy, authentic lives.


